

# FINEVIEW COMMUNITY GARDEN RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Each gardener is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of their garden plot. Watering, weeding, harvesting and any other garden related maintenance are all the responsibility of the gardener. Gardeners may arrange for other gardeners to water and maintain their plots.
2. Bring your own gardening tools; you may keep them in the Community Garden Shed which will be locked with a shared combination lock.
3. Water may be available in the provided Rain Barrels.
4. Children are welcome in the garden but must be accompanied by an adult and must be supervised at all times.
5. No alcohol or illegal drugs permitted in the Community Garden.
6. Each gardener must complete a **RELEASE of CLAIMS** form before any work in the garden can begin.
7. Garden plots should be cared for at least once a week. It is the gardener's responsibility to notify the coordinator (DIANN MALCOLM, 412.323.8288) if he or she is not able to care for their plot. If any plot remains unattended for more than four weeks, that plot is subject to reassignment, no refunds.
8. The application of herbicides (weed killers) to garden plots is prohibited.
9. Assignment of garden plots is first come first serve. Preference for next year's plots will be given to this year's participants first.
10. Plot fees are due in full before the garden season begins on May 1st. Prices subject to change on an annual basis. 2017 fees: \$5.00
11. Gardeners may harvest vegetables, herbs and flowers from their garden only.

12. At the end of the growing season, gardeners are responsible for clearing their plot of all plant material and leaving the plot as they found it in the spring.
